## CODE OF CONDUCT

## ST. FELIM'S N.S. FARNHAM ST., CAVAN

- 1. Respect for all pupils and staff is of the utmost importance. Pupils must show respect for all visitors to the school and show pride in all school activities particularly when on outside trips and visits.
- 2. Punctuality is most important. School begins at 9am and finishes at 2.40pm and we are all expected to be present during this time.
- 3. Full uniform must be worn to school. Pupils should have name-tags on their coats and uniforms. Full PE uniform must be worn on days when class is scheduled to have PE, swimming, tennis, gymnastics or coaching. Neat, tidy appearance is expected off all pupils and the wearing of earrings is not allowed.
- 4. Smoking is strictly forbidden in St. Felim's NS.
- 5. A written letter of explanation signed by their parents will be expected if pupils are absent, wish to be excused during school or have not completed their homework.
- 6. At both 11am and 1pm pupils must leave their classroom before the teacher.
- 7. In the interests of a positive and happy playground all pupils will abide by break/lunchtime rules as outlined in Code of Behaviour. (Available on Website).
- 8. During break-times, at 11am and 1pm, all pupils must remain in the school yard. The following are completely out of bounds:

  Cana House, the woods, the small yard and the front of the school.
- 9. Pupils are expected to keep their classrooms and the school grounds neat, tidy and free of litter. Chewing gum is strictly forbidden in school and on school grounds.
- 10. All school buildings and property will be treated with respect also.
- 11. The lollipop-person must be respected and obeyed. Any complaints from him/her will be followed up and dealt with.
- 12. Mobile phones are not allowed in school. If a pupil needs to contact home every effort will be made to facilitate him.
